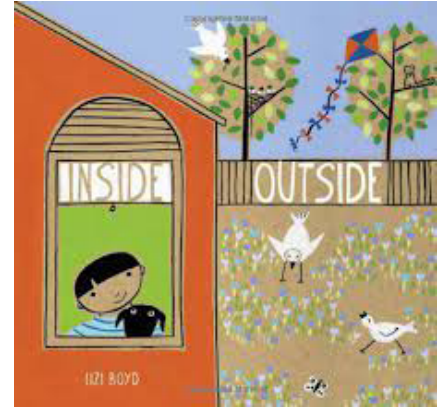




A Guide to *Inside Outside*
