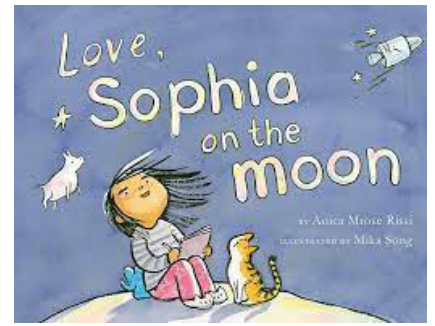




A Guide to *Love, Sophia on the Moon*
